- 1) Extra-Curricular Transportation
 - a. During the August 31 Policy Committee meeting, committee members questioned the feasibility of drafting a policy to address district expectations for transportation to extra-curricular activities.
 - b. After discussions with Activities Director Curt Jones and Transportation Director Brad Redmond, Superintendent Flowers shared with the Policy Committee that drafts of a policy addressing extra-curricular transportation will be brought to the next committee meeting for review and discussion.

- 2) Academic Eligibility for Co-Curricular Activities
 - a. This policy was brought forward at the August 31 meeting for review. At that time, committee members wanted clarification on the addition of specific language about the impact of block vs. skinny courses on a student's eligibility.
 - b. After discussion with WFHS administration, it was determined that the addition of that specific language was not necessary to the administration of the policy.
 - c. This policy will go before the full board for a first reading at their next meeting.

- 3) Education of Special Education Students in Non-Public Schools
 - a. This policy was determined by administration to be out-of-date and no longer a necessary part of the policy manual. The full board will be asked to consider the deletion of this policy at their next meeting.
