

DRESS CODE:

West Fargo Public Schools seek to maintain an orderly environment for education. To accomplish this, we have set a standard of student dress that is conducive to a proper education climate. Clothing worn by students shall be neat, clean, and in good repair for the general personal health and safety of the student. Immodest clothing of such type that distracts from the learning process shall not be worn. Some of the items we do not allow students to wear or display are:

1. Hats, caps, or bandannas
2. Any item that advertises drugs/alcohol/tobacco
3. Skirts or shorts that do not reach at or near the fingertips
4. See-through items
5. Tight or revealing clothing
6. Bare midriffs or crop tops
7. Halters, strapless dresses or tops

Students who come to school dressed inappropriately will be expected to change. Their parents will be contacted to bring appropriate clothing. They will not be permitted to attend classes in inappropriate clothing.
