

COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL MAKING "TRACKS" TO GRADUATION



In order for Community High School to continue to assist students to earn credits to graduate we have developed some new rules and two tracks.

For students who pass classes and earn credits they are rewarded for their efforts through the **Personal Responsibility Track**. The P.R.T. is the system we have currently in place. Students are able to:

- Have discretionary time (earned by meeting deadlines) up to two hours
- Have course selection priority.
- Participate in game time and other social activities.

For those that fail a course, they are placed on the accountability track (see below).

Students can work their way back up the ladder by passing two classes in a row. Passing two classes in a row moves the student to the left one column no matter which track they are on, except a fourth failure.

Students who do not abide by the rules will face disciplinary action which may include suspension or being withdrawn from Community High School.
