

## WFPS Health and Safety Guidelines

### June 2021

Priorities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Implement reasonable accommodations to reduce school-wide and community spread</li> </ul>
Districtwide Practices:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face coverings no longer mandated for staff and students</li> <li>• Physical distancing where possible</li> <li>• Buildings routinely cleaned and disinfected; special focus on high touch/traffic areas</li> <li>• Handwashing integrated throughout the day</li> <li>• Hand sanitizer available throughout each building</li> <li>• Students and staff that have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or more, an undiagnosed rash or sores, vomiting, diarrhea, or a contagious infection diagnosed by a healthcare provider should stay home until 24 hours after symptoms improve</li> <li>• Students and staff that have a loss of taste or smell should stay home for 10 days, unless they can provide a negative COVID test or an alternate diagnosis from a healthcare provider</li> <li>• Students and staff who test positive for COVID-19 will be required to isolate for 10 days</li> <li>• District will encourage students and staff that are notified they are close contacts to a positive case outside of school to complete their recommended quarantine period, unless vaccinated</li> <li>• District will no longer contact trace</li> <li>• District will provide exposure notifications to all families in the classroom if there is a positive case in their child's classroom <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ If there are fewer than 10 students enrolled in the class, exposure notifications are unable to be sent, per privacy guidelines.</li> <li>○ The exposure notifications will encourage families to self-monitor their child and to keep them home if symptoms develop</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Classrooms will transition to distance learning if there are 3 or more connected COVID-19 cases in one room</li> </ul>
Schools:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Protective measures will be implemented in office spaces</li> <li>• School events, assemblies, and gatherings allowed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Face coverings no longer mandated for guests and visitors</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Classrooms:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face coverings no longer mandated for staff and students</li> <li>• Desks arranged to allow for cohort groups and distancing where possible</li> <li>• Seating charts required</li> </ul>
Extracurricular Activities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face coverings no longer mandated for staff, students, and spectators</li> <li>• Guidance and directives from the NDHSAA and other governing boards will be used to guide these activities</li> <li>• Live stream when possible</li> </ul>
