### Additional Items of Note

- For families interested in a fully virtual option, WFPS will help them enroll their child(ren) in the North Dakota Center for Distance Education and cover the costs of this enrollment. The district will hold the student's spot in their home school, and upon the availability of vaccines, or sooner if the family is comfortable, the student may return to school.
  - Please contact your child's principal if you are interested in this option.
- COVID-19 vaccination is not required for school attendance or participation in activities.
- The district will NOT be identifying students as close contacts with a requirement to quarantine.
  - Instead, exposure notifications will be provided to all families in the classroom if there is a positive case in their child's classroom. The exposure notifications will encourage families to self-monitor their child and to keep them home if symptoms develop.
- School activities, events, assemblies, and gatherings allowed, with no limits on spectators.
