Description: Physical Science is a lab-based course that introduces the student to the fundamentals of chemistry and physics. Students will use formulas and mathematical manipulation to develop and demonstrate their science knowledge. This course sets the foundation for some elective sciences offered at West Fargo High School. This course meets every other day.

Requirements:

Attendance- Students are expected to show up to class on-time. Students who miss class because of an excused absence will be given the amount of days they are gone, plus 1 day (according to school policy) to complete and turn-in the missed work. An unexcused absence means students will not be able to make up any work or points given that class. School excused absences are required to be mentioned at least **THREE** days prior so all possible material can be given to the student. If materials are not prepared at that time, I will work with you on creating a personal plan. Communication is key*.

Late work- No late work penalty will be applied. However, there will be a hard deadline for the end of the unit for that unit's work. Sometimes deadlines might be put in place in the middle of the unit. Please keep up with the schedule and what is in Powerschool to know of these deadlines. Communication is key*.

Tardies- Students who show up 20 minutes after class has started will be marked unverified (UV). Every 5th tardy in the semester will result in a UV. Refer to the student handbook for more specifics.

Powerschool: Grades will be available through Powerschool**. I will keep a paper gradebook and update Powerschool from it. Please allow for at least 5 school days for assignments to be in (*i.e. do not expect me to grade something overnight so you meet eligibility*). If you are a parent/guardian please email me with any questions after you have discussed with your students and still need assistance. Students are expected to stay up-to-date on their grades and missing assignments. Please come to me with any questions or concerns regarding Powerschool. Communication is key*.

Retakes/Improving Grade: Retakes on quizzes/tests will be allowed occasionally meaning not every quiz or tests will have the option to retake. Students who are actively participating in class, giving their best effort, asking questions, and attending WIN sessions will be given priority when doing retakes. Retakes will require a reflection form, series of tasks (usually from the unit), signature from parent/guardian, and finding a time outside of class time to complete the retake. Students should pay attention in class and always ask if retakes will be available for them. Communication is key*.

Online Access: Online access for each student is expected in some way outside of class. If this is not available to you or your student please let me know. I will work with you and your student to find an alternative route. Communication is key*.

OneNote/Schoology: OneNote is the **MAIN PLATFORM** for this class. You will be expected to keep it up-to-date and complete your work in it. If you prefer paper copies, feel free to print at home or at the library but you **MUST** place a picture on the page in OneNote. This will allow for things to always be available. If your OneNote is not syncing or just acting up, try signing back into OneDrive and if it still isn't working, contact me! Occasionally we might complete assignments in Schoology or submit pages from OneNote to Schoology. Make sure you are paying attention and checking my schedule if you are confused. Feel free to email me as well with any questions. Communication is key*.

Resources: I will keep my schedule as up-to-date as possible. The schedule will be the "hub" of what we do in class. It will say where certain assignments are completed and **MUST be used if the student is absent**. Students should look at the schedule when they miss class **FIRST**, then come to me with any questions they may have about that day's assignment(s). Communication is key*.

Also, depending on the situation, parents, case workers, and/or administrators will also be notified of the incident.

- *When writing papers, lab reports, and other assignments requiring significant writing, students will NOT be allowed to use artificial intelligence (AI). If a student does, it will be treated as plagiarism.*
