

FOOD PROGRAMS

BREAKFAST PROGRAM

Our school participates in a breakfast program. Breakfast is served each day. We ask that children report and eat breakfast during the arranged time slot in order to report to class on time. Parents may purchase breakfast tickets during registration or by visiting with the breakfast supervisor in the multi-purpose room each morning.

Our school district also has an online MySchoolBucks.com processing system where parents can pay for meals online and track student meal accounts. Please visit the district website at www.west-fargo.k12.nd.us and select the MySchoolBucks.com icon.

HOT LUNCHESES, BREAKFASTS & MILK/JUICE PROGRAM

Breakfasts and hot lunches are served daily with a desire to provide students with nutritious meals at minimum prices. Meals are purchased with funds you have deposited into your child's account. Please keep track of your child's account by checking for notes sent home when your child's account gets low. Students eligible to receive free or reduced meals will be charged accordingly. Children will lose the privilege of eating in the lunchroom if they do not follow the cafeteria rules. They are expected to be courteous and have appropriate table manners. Milk or juice is served during mid-morning break times.

MILK/JUICE PROGRAM

Milk or juice is served once a day for all students. A student may choose either milk or juice option daily. Teachers will receive a list of students receiving milk or juice due to payment.

MEAL PROGRAMS

Our school district operates meal programs under the School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program. Healthy, nutritious meals are planned to meet all nutritional guidelines set by the USDA.

Breakfast is offered in all school buildings before the school day. Students who wish to eat breakfast should report to the cafeteria during the assigned meal times. Lunches are available daily, and consist of a choice between two entrees, milk, and a fruit and veggie bar. Milk or juice is available daily for elementary students for mid-morning break. Parents must purchase the milk selection for a semester.

An online meal payment system is available for parents to pre-pay for meals. Parents may set up an account under www.myschoolbucks.com. Funds may be deposited conveniently online using a credit/debit card, or can be sent to the school office by cash or check to add to a student's account. Parents have access to fund balance information and meal transaction history on their myschoolbucks.com account. Students must have funds in their accounts in order to eat meals, and meals may not be charged.

Free or Reduced priced meals are available to those who qualify. Applications for Free and Reduced meals are available in the school office or the district website at www.west-fargo.k12.nd.us/district/menus/Application.pdf
