

SECONDARY INCLEMENT WEATHER SCHEDULE

Middle schools and high schools follow their one-hour late start schedule for an inclement weather day, including the A/B daily schedule. There is no advisory on inclement weather days. The first half of the class is synchronous learning via Microsoft Teams and the second half of the class is time to work on assignments and activities.

Our current instructional models provide the ability for students to learn from home and staff to teach from home when weather conditions prohibit them from getting to school. Middle school and high school students are expected to bring their device to school each day and home each evening in order to be prepared for an inclement weather day.

If school is cancelled due to inclement weather, the inclement weather schedule is in place for the elementary, middle, and high school levels. All synchronous sessions in Microsoft Teams are recorded for students who miss the session. Attendance is entered in PowerSchool based on synchronous attendance and/or work completion.
