



MCKINNEY - VENTO HOMELESS ASSISTANCE ACT

WHO IS HOMELESS?

Any individual who lacks a fixed, regular, or adequate nighttime residence, including unaccompanied youth or children who live in hotels, campgrounds, vehicles, shelters, or are staying with family due to economic hardship.

WHAT ARE THE RIGHTS OF HOMLESS CHILDREN?

If found to be eligible for services under the McKinney - Vento Homeless Assistance Act, school-aged children have the right to immediately attend school, participate in activities, attend their school of origin, receive transportation services, and receive school-provided breakfast and lunch.

HOW DO I GET HELP?

Contact your child's school and ask about additional services that may be available to homeless children.
