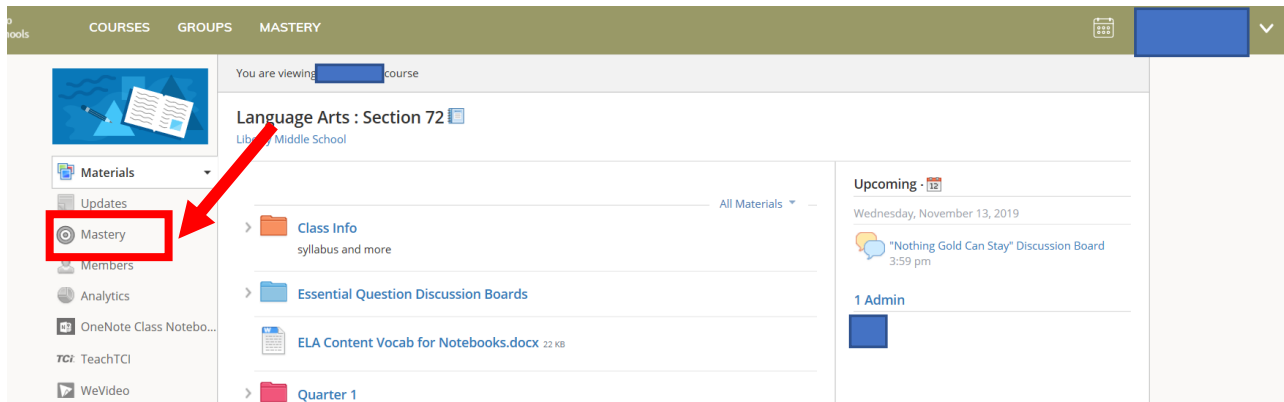


1. Once **logged** into Schoology, use the drop-down menu next to your name to choose your child. This page displays information about your child's calendar, courses and upcoming events/due dates.
2. To view student grades, select one **Course**. Then click on **Mastery** on the left-hand side of the screen.



3. From here you will see day-to-day assessments broken down. On the left, you will see the category standard and the level of proficiency. You can click on the category to see the learning objectives and individual assessments your child has completed and view their work.
